

Proiect eTwinning

Începând din luna ianuarie 2019, Școala Gimnazială "Miron Costin" Suceava desfășoară, în parteneriat cu Școala Vedruna FEC din Pamplona, Spania, un proiect e-Twinning.

Proiectul se numește *Comparing Schools in Europe* și constă în prezentarea, de către elevii din cele două școli, a sistemelor de educație din care fac parte, cu scopul realizării unei analize care să pună în evidență asemănările și deosebirile dintre ele. Limba de comunicare este engleza.

Fiecare școală a construit un padlet, încărcat pe site-ul eTwinning, iar comunicarea se realizează pe grupul proiectului, prin întrebări și răspunsuri despre cele două școli, dar și prin întâlniri online pe Skype.

My school

- The students' school council**
Our school has a school council formed by representatives of the students, who are elected by the secondary school pupils. They initiate different activities, mostly the extra-school ones, and they get involved in accomplishing them.

- Scoala Gimnaziala "Miron Costin" Suceava has 1397 students (primary and secondary school) and 64 teachers. it is the biggest in the county of Suceava. Historically, the region in which our town is situated is called Bucovina. It lies in the north-east of Romania and it is famous for its beautiful environment and for its monasteries and its churches. Some of them were built in the 16th century. Our town is the capital of the county with the same name, Suceava. Our school is called "Miron Costin", the name of an important historian of the province of Moldova.**
There are 30 classes at primary level, with students between 6 and 10 years old and 20 secondary school classes, with students between 11 and 15 years old.

Timetable

- School timetable**
Since we are such a big school, the programme is organised in two shifts, both for primary and secondary school students. Primary school students who are in preparatory, first and second class come to school in the morning, from 8 to 12, while the ones who are in the third and fourth class have lessons between 12 to 4 or 5 pm. As for secondary school students, the fifth and eighth classes have lessons in the morning, from 8 am to 1 or 2 pm, and their mates in the sixth and seventh classes come to school in the afternoon, from 1 or 2 pm until 6 or 7 pm. It may sound like an inconvenient, but we are used to it, so everything is fine.
The number of classes depends on the studying level.
- School subjects**
There are many subjects for students in our country and, consequently, in our school. Depending on the level of education, they have classes of Romanian, mathematics, sciences (biology, physics, chemistry), history, geography, social education, computer science, technology, art, music, physical education, religious education, languages. In primary school they study only one foreign language, English. Starting from secondary school, they have two foreign languages, English and French or German. For each language, there are two classes a week. In the eighth class, students also have a Latin class a week. A class lasts 50 minutes and the break is 10 minutes' long. In primary school students have four or five classes a day, which in secondary school, they have five or six classes a day.
- Holidays**
The school year is organized in two terms. This year, the first term is between 11th September 2018 and 2nd February 2019, During this term, there is the

- Bucovina, culture home**
